Still Standing The Beauty of Southern Trees by Gary Mullane

Rediscover the trees of the Lowcountry with the exhibit *Still Standing, the Beauty of Southern Trees* by Gary Mullane this August at Art League Gallery. Gary's relationship with trees began over forty years ago. Working as a tree consultant, Gary obtained a degree in Arboriculture and Park Management from the Stockbridge School of Agriculture at the University of Massachusetts. Gary was twice awarded national excellence in Arboriculture for his work in preserving trees at Marriott's Grande Ocean

Resort and Shelter Cove's Disney Resort. One may argue, that no one else on Hilton Head knows trees like Gary Mullane does.

After a long career of preserving trees, Gary began to photograph trees. Because of his career, Gary views a tree differently than most. "Taking photographs of trees is not easy, most I've seen are from the outside showing a big mass of green leaves. Since I know how trees work and grow, I've tried to capture the power, strength, fragility, size and delicate balance that trees have to survive" states Gary. Gary is the author of "Still Standing, the Beauty of Southern Trees" which will be available for purchase during the exhibit.

Stop by the gallery for a new perspective on the Lowcountry's beautiful live oaks and palmettos while learning how they persevere by a local tree expert. *Still Standing, the Beauty of Southern Trees* by Gary Mullane will be on exhibition at Art League Gallery, July 31 - August 25, 2018. This workshop is for students at all skill levels.





Now again the Symphony requests artwork for its 2018-2019 HHSO program book entitled SOUNDWAVES to highlight the HHSO's new office space and building, SoundWaves, at 7 Lagoon Road in Coligny.

Much of the music might be available on the internet or YouTube. There will be an opportunity for exhibiting your work at the post-concert receptions on Monday night.

What we are looking for:

- -Any artist age 18 and over, that is an <u>Exhibiting Member Artist of Art League of Hilton Head</u>, is welcome to submit. Any medium is accepted. Please do not submit images from last year's program.
- -Art must be an original piece, again preferably related to a specific concert theme/music, or with reference to the new facility "Soundwaves" near Coligny, beach scenes. The Program Designer selects images that can be combined with the description of the composition in the Program.

Entry Deadline:

Friday, August 17, 2018. Submissions must be made in digital format (<u>see Guidelines here</u>). Download Adobe Acrobat Reader from https://get.adobe.com/reader/otherversions

- -All artists agree to have their images posted online.
- -Artists will have at least one piece of work selected for the Program.
- -The Guideline requires that images are at least 5 x 7 with 300 dpi minimum or larger. Please consider that you may want to exhibit them post-concert or in the gallery, so best not to make them too small.
- -Artworks may be sold at the post-concert receptions. A 20% commission is to be paid to Art League.


