Join Gabriele Hoffman at Art League Academy and learn all about one of the most influential periods in art! Impressionism remains one of the most coveted styles in art to this day. What brought about this revolutionary, new way of painting? What obstacles did the movement have to overcome to find acceptance? You will discover all of this and more in this upcoming presentation packed full of exciting information!

Gabriele, who was born in Munich, Germany, moved to France at a young age where she perfected her French and visited art museums such as Orsay, Jeu de Paume, Picasso Museum and the Louvre. After two years, she moved to New York City where she spent 26 years embracing arts & culture. There, Gabriele obtained her BA and MA in Art History, specifically Modernism 1850s - 1960s and wrote an 85-page thesis on Paul Klee's late work.

Gabriele has worked at the J. Pierpont Morgan Library, the Metropolitan Museum and the Neue Galerie, Ronald Lauder's private museum of Austrian & German Expressionism. Gabriele moved to the Lowcountry in 2006 where she has worked for multiple Arts organizations including Art League of Hilton Head and the Arts Center of Coastal Carolina.

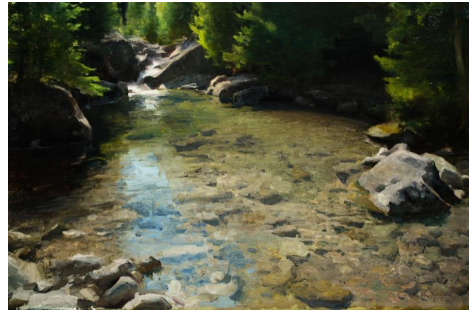
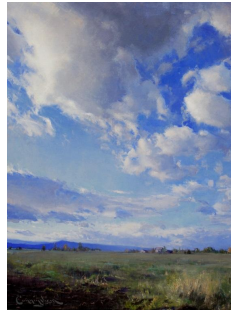

For a minute consider the three most common genera of representational art: still life, portraiture and landscape painting. Of the three, landscape painting is typically regarded as the easiest because it tends to be a more forgiving subject. While this may be true in some instances, the landscape does offer many distinct challenges. During this landscape painting class, TJ Cunningham will focus on the two challenges that he considers the greatest impediment to a successful landscape painting; how to create atmosphere and how to sculpt the landscape so that the trees seem vertical while the surrounding landscape appears flat.

This entire class will take place in the safety of the studio. Unlike plein air painting, where speed and direct observation are critical, the painting time in this class will address the ideas more thoroughly behind a good landscape painting. TJ will begin each day with a presentation of his working process. The attendees will also receive clear instruction on how to simplify the landscape in an expressive way. Painting quality, value pattern, and abstraction will all be discussed as valuable tools when used in landscape painting.

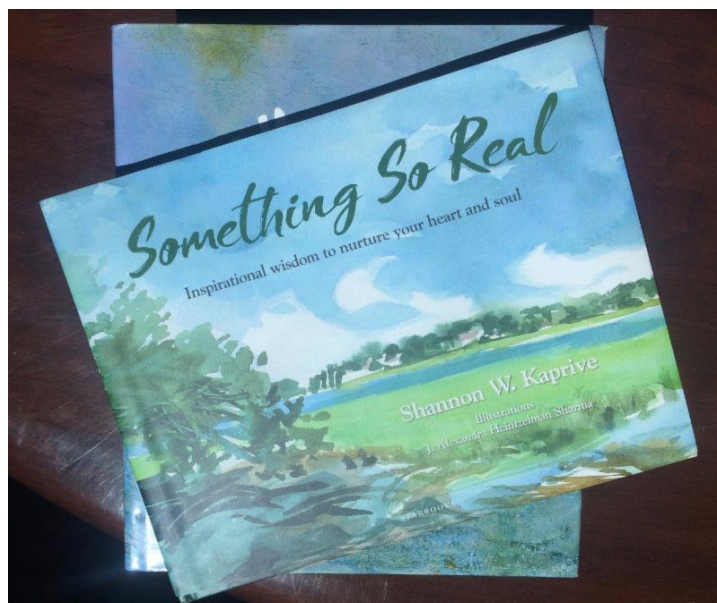

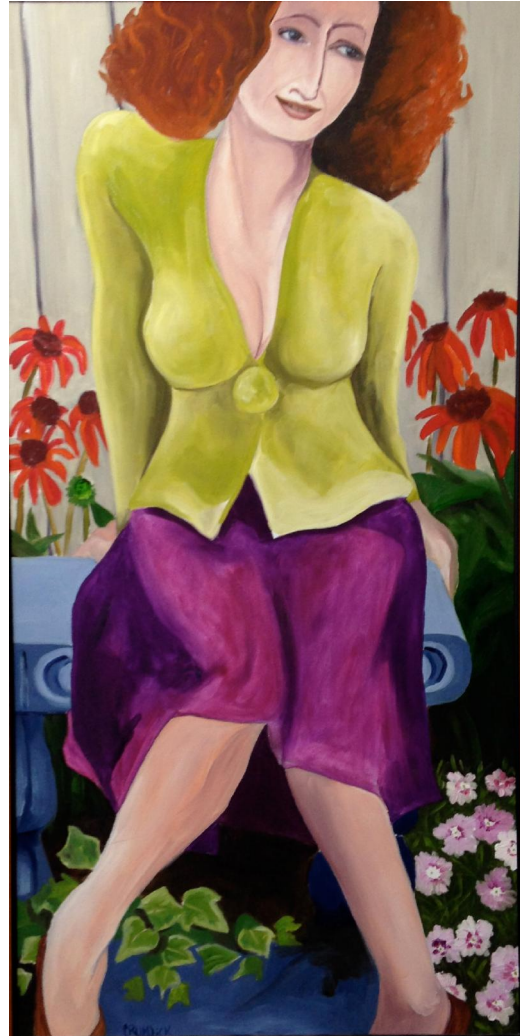

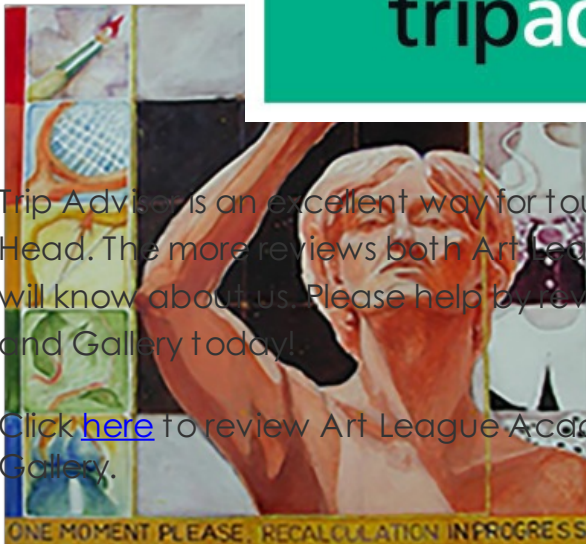
