IMPORTANT EXHIBITION GUIDELINES:

- Artwork must be original in conception and execution. No kits, copies, or work from published photos. 'Fakes' (copies of well-known art) are not allowed except during our "Fabulous Fakes" exhibition.
- 2D artwork should not exceed 20 lbs.. 3D should not exceed 25lbs.
- Framed artwork must not exceed 36" x 48".
- Framing wire is required, except for metal-backed artworks.
 - The wire should be tight and no more than 1/4 from the top of the piece.
 - Using string, fishing line or any other hanging material is unacceptable.
 - Framing wire must be attached using d-rings or screw eyes.
 - The hanging wire must be completely hidden behind the frame.
- Small Wall artworks must be 10" x 10" or less including the frame and less than \$100.
- Frames, glass & Plexiglass must be free of scratches and in clean condition.
