Since the year 2000, Art League of Hilton Head awards a **\$2000** scholarship to a graduating high school senior studying or living in Beaufort County, who has been accepted into an accredited art school or a college where he/she will be majoring in the visual arts. Only one scholarship will be awarded each year. The successful applicant will be selected based on an interview, a review of a portfolio and completion of this application.

Since 2020, Art League has been awarding an additional scholarship to a student from a low-income family pursuing a major in visual arts. The Barbara and Clayton Kittinger Scholarship will award **\$1000**.
