

Carol Iglesias Acrylic Materials List

The following is a list of items that I like to use. These are only suggestions. You may use whatever materials that you have or prefer.

The items in bold are the most important supplies needed.

- √ **Acrylics**- (I primarily use a limited palette of Titanium White, Yellow Medium, Quinacridone Magenta, Phthalo Blue, Phthalo Green and Carbon Black)
- √ **Small Sketchbook** (I use 3.5" x 5" Strathmore Sketch)
- √ **(2) Painting Panels** 11 x 14 or 12 x 16 are good sizes. (I use Centurion LX Universal Primed Linen Painting Panels.) Many options available online thru Jerry's Artarama or Dick Blick)
- √ **Brushes**- Long Handle (I use **Filbert** or Egbert Brushes numbers **2,4,6,8,10** and one old #2 bristle for drawing)
- √ **Baby Wipes** and/or **Paper Towels** (Viva or Shop Towels are best!)
- √ **Black Ultra Fine Tip Pen** (for sketching. I like uni ball gel pens)
- √ **3 Values of Gray Markers** (I like the No.1, 3 and 5 Cool Gray)
- √ **Water or OPEN Thinner** to slow the drying.
- √ **Mixing Surface** or disposable palettes.
- √ Some sort of ViewCatcher is nice to have.
- √ **Photos** your own to use as reference.
